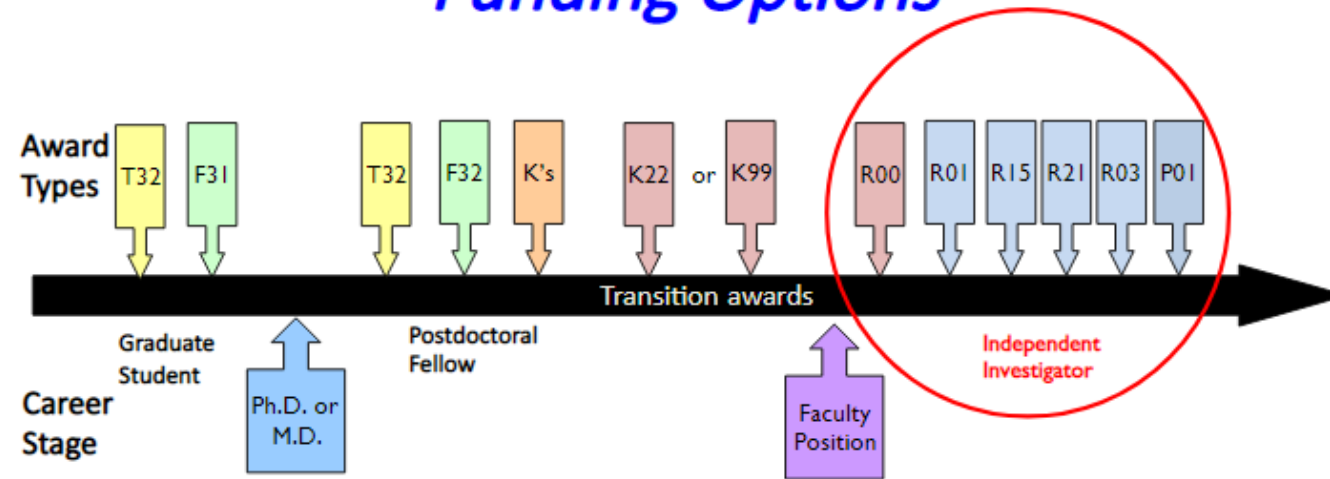
Goals of the Grant Writing Workshop

Extramural Scientist Career Path and NIH Funding Options

Extramural Scientist Career Path and NIH Funding Options



- R00 – Independent phase of K99/R00 Pathway to Independence
- R01 – Research Project Grant (up to 5 years of support, renewable)
- R03 – Small Research Grant (up to 2 years of support, non-renewable)
- R15 – Academic Research Enhancement Award (AREA) (up to 3 years, renewable)
- R21 – Exploratory/Developmental Research Grant (up to 2 years of support, non-renewable)
- P01 – Program Project Grant (multi-project grant, up to 5 years of support, renewable)
